Publack Library Publishing's mission is to create and publish representative, relatable, and enjoyable children's literature.

Growing up, many books that were read to me and books I read myself were typically non-inclusive. Neither the author nor the characters looked like me and often the contents of those books were unrelatable. I believe this had a big part in my underperformance in academia in comparison to my counterparts.

To help close the literacy gap and diversify the literary world, I started to write inclusive literature for underrepresented children which has now expanded to an entire publishing company. It is our obligation at Publack Library Publishing to get as many representative children's books into the hands of underrepresented youth.

We appreciate you joining us on this amazing journey. Your contributions will be used solely to fund the publishing process of diverse children's literature. Once these books are published several copies will be donated to local libraries, community centers, and daycare centers in low-income areas around the United States. Copies of our books will also be available for purchase on our website and available at community events and bookstores.

The average cost to publish a book from cover to cover is approximately \$2,000. In addition, every \$100 can print 5 hardcover books or 15 paperback books. All sponsors have full control over their donation amount with unlimited freedom to donate.
